MS NORDSTJERNEN

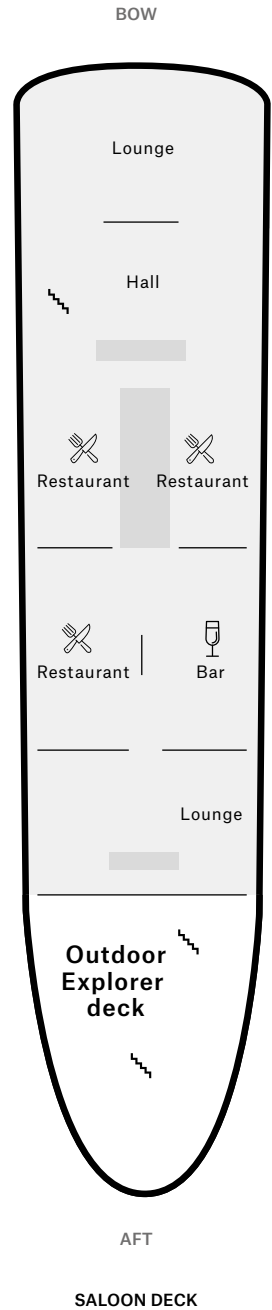
